Building a Brighter Future for Hispanic Families in Rochester

ACHLA-Alliance of Chicanos, Hispanics, and Latin Americans is proud to launch and sustain several life-changing programs that empower Hispanic families in Rochester. Your support is essential. Below are the key initiatives we are fundraising for—each one building toward equity, opportunity, and stability for our community.

Case for Support - Support our mission. Inspire our youth.

COMPASS OF CARE PROJECT

Sponsorship request: \$50,000

About: To help stabilize vulnerable families, trained Community Navigators provide housing support, education and healthcare system navigation, and help to set personal goals. These efforts directly impact children's success in Rochester Public Schools by strengthening their home environments. Help stabilize vulnerable Hispanic families in Rochester.

Sponsorship Request: We're seeking \$50,000 to continue housing stabilization efforts in partnership with St. Vincent de Paul, Three Rivers CAP, and the Rochester School District. Last year, ACHLA assisted over 90 households, averaging \$400–\$500 per case in direct support.

COMMUNITY BIKE WORKSHOP & MENTORSHIP

Sponsorship request: \$10,000

About: This hands-on program empowers youth and adults to maintain and use donated bikes for transportation to work, school, and recreation. The workshop builds skills in bike maintenance, promotes self-reliance and mobility, and encourages environmental stewardship. It also serves as a hub for mentorship, volunteerism, and community connection.

Sponsorship Request: To continue this work, ACHLA is seeking a \$10,000 investment to support a part-time staff member from April through October. This role is essential to:

- manage bookkeeping and sales
- coordinate training and volunteer schedules
- maintain bike inventory and toolkits
- provide customer service at the front store.
- \$100 gives one child a bike

ORGANIZATIONAL CAPACITY BUILDING

Sponsorship request: \$24,000

About: Behind every successful program is a strong foundation. ACHLA needs ongoing support for accounting, operations, grant writing, and program evaluation—key infrastructure that ensures we can sustain and grow our impact. Currently, ACHLA has two FT, two PT, five independent contractors, and several lead teachers and paraprofessionals.

Sponsorship Request: With the conclusion of our NIGP funding, ACHLA is seeking \$24,000 funding to support capacity building efforts of our part-time bookkeeper who manages QuickBooks entries, track expenses and deposits, and ensure compliance with grant budgets across multiple accounts. This role is essential for maintaining financial accuracy, accountability, and transparency as we continue to grow our programs and partnerships.

An investment in this position will directly support our capacity to responsibly steward public and private funds.

Through community engagement, education, and outreach programs, we strive to create a more inclusive and equitable society for all.

SOCCER LEAGUE

Sponsorship request: \$10,000

About: ACHLA's Southeast MN Soccer Club brings together Latino children and their families in Rochester to promote physical health, teamwork, and cultural pride. More than just a sport, this program strengthens community bonds, supports youth mentorship, and creates a safe space for families to connect and grow.

The next season runs from July 15th to December 15th 2025, serving up to 93 youth participants.

Sponsorship Request: We are seeking \$10,000 to support the upcoming soccer season, which will fund:

- Field rental and equipment,
- · Team uniforms and supplies
- Stipends for youth coaches
- Healthy snacks and family engagement events.
- \$1,000 helps support 10 youth participate in soccer for the season

ACHLA'S COMMUNITY LEGAL CLINICS

Sponsorship request: \$5,000

About: ACHLA is not a legal services provider but collaborates with legal professionals and nonprofit partners to ensure families can access the resources and support they need. Many families rely on ACHLA to organize and host free legal education clinics that offer "Know Your Rights and Responsibilities" sessions, as well as access to free legal guidance through trusted legal service partners—building trust, knowledge, and stronger communities. In 2025, ACHLA coordinated five clinics, each reaching more than 120 community members.

Sponsorship Request: We are seeking \$5,000. Each clinic costs approximately \$600 to organize and includes:

- Outreach and educational materials
- printing and interpretation
- food and community engagement
- volunteer coordination and event logistics.
- \$750 helps provide a legal clinic

POST-FUNDING SUPPORT FOR ENRICHMENT PROGRAMS

Sponsorship request: \$2,500

About: Programs like Juntos Club offer after-school tutoring, Spanish enrichment, cultural arts, and college-readiness trips. These programs that increase the sense of belonging, boost academic success, and celebrate Latin identity. Post-grant funding is crucial to keeping them in school.

Sponsorship Request: College visits cost about \$2,500 - includes bus transportation for 40 Future First-generation scholars, snacks, and writing supplies. Your investment plants the seed of hope and ambition in the next generation of leaders.

Invest Day at the Capital in social justice events where youth voices are heard at the State Capital \$2,500 including same as above.



Across our community, too many students—especially those from culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds—are falling behind. FastBridge assessments show rising numbers of learners identified as "at risk" or "some risk." These children deserve more than just hope—they need targeted academic support, consistent mentorship, and meaningful opportunities to lead and belong. ACHLA's afterschool initiative is meeting this moment with culturally responsive tutoring, leadership activities, and family engagement that reflect the lived experiences of the youth we serve.
